The Black Cats Must Have Gone Crazy

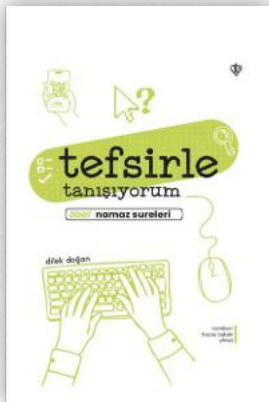

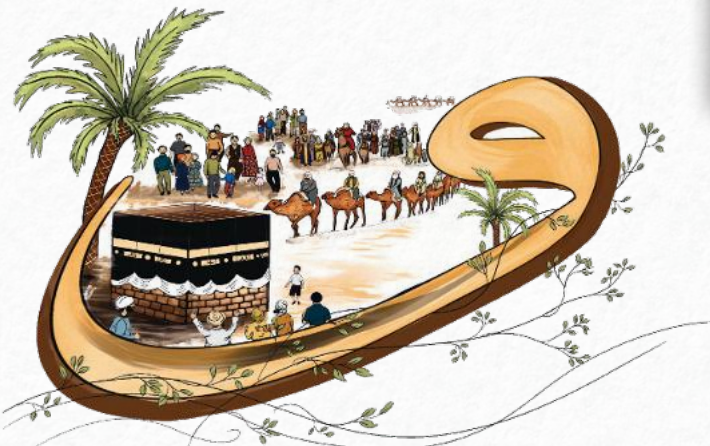

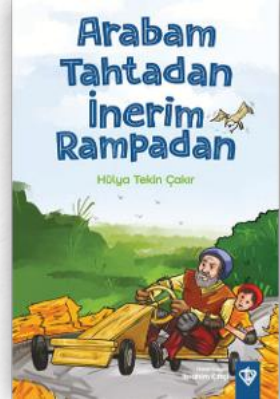

The Essence in Our Hearts

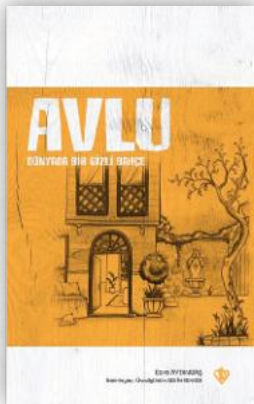

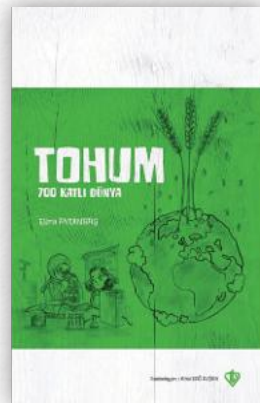
